

The Willow Marsh Farm FAQ'S

What are the dimensions of your fire place, main doorway and tables?

- The large fireplace in the Grand barn is 234cm long by 15 cm deep.
- Our tables are 183 cm long by 90 cm wide. For place setting and table runners please work on 62 cm per person and allow some material for draping at the ends.
- Our main barn door entrance is 245 cm high by 153 cm wide.

Can we use candles on the farm?

- Open flamed candles are permitted on tables but only if they in covered glass jars. Naked flames like candelabra are not permitted.

Can we use confetti at the farm?

- Confetti is permitted for use outside the barn but **must** be natural flowers. Plastic confetti and confetti cannons are not allowed and if used with sadly result in a clean up fee deducted from your damage deposit.

Can we bring our own flowers our use our own florist?

- Yes absolutely you are more than welcome to use whoever you wish when it comes to decorating the barn with flowers. We do however ask that all flowers are cleared from the venue the morning after your wedding day.

Can we have a band or D7?

- We love live music and bands and DJ's are welcome to play at the farm on your wedding day. We do however ask that they play through our RCF Evox 12 PA system. This can be done by plugging into an XLR socket in the barn. Bands and DJ's must be made aware of this prior to your event. All doors and windows in the barn will be closed once the party starts as this helps protect our neighbours from disturbance.

What time does the bar close and music stop?

- The party stops at midnight, as does our bar service. Taxis home or to local accommodation should be organised for then. All guests not staying at the Willow Marsh Farm should kindly exit the site by 12:45 am.

Who do we contact to organise the registrar?

- Your civil ceremony must be organised by yourselves and it can be done by calling 0300 500 8080. The farm is in the Rushcliffe district so our nearest registry office is in West Bridgeford.

Can we have a fireworks display?

- Fireworks are **not** permitted in any areas of the farm. We have horses and cattle living in the fields, so sadly sparklers are the nearest alternative and are permitted for outside use only.

Can our guests camp at the farm?

- We don't allow guests to free camp in our fields, we have lots of wonderful nearby accommodation options for them. However if you wish to hire a bell tent village then this is allowed depending on the season.

Is there a damage deposit?

- Yes we have a refundable damage deposit of £ 1000 that is repaid the week following your event. Any damages made will be deducted from the total after discussion with yourselves.
